Materials from the PTA Closet:

1. Bags with cut squares – labeled with teacher's name

Class materials for each child:

1. Glue stick
2. Scissors

Instructions:

1. Each child should receive one large square and four small squares. All five squares should be different colors from each other. They can trade squares with classmates if they would like a different color than those they receive. They should also have a glue stick and scissors at their desk.
2. Place colored paper scraps in the middle of each group of desks (they are included in the bag with the squares)

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# Art Smart 2: Britto

\*\*\* In this project the children will be using acrylic paints which are difficult to remove from clothing. Please have them wear a smock. If your teacher would prefer not to use these paints then you can have the class use markers, colored pencils, or crayons instead.

## Materials from the PTA Closet: Box Labeled Britto

1. Sheets printed with “Art Smart Presents Romero Britto” – enough for each student in your class
2. One bag of paints – each child is to receive one paint container at a time and can then trade with a classmate. Please remind them not to use all of the paint in that container.
3. Enough paint brushes for each student in your class
4. Roll of paper towel
5. Paper cups to be filled with water to wash paint brushes

## Class materials for each child:

1. Pencil with eraser
2. Black Sharpie
3. Ruler
4. SMOCK

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# Art Smart 3: Pointillism

To be completed 03/01/19-05/01/19

Materials from the PTA Closet: Box Labeled Pointillism

6. Sheets printed with “Art Smart Presents Pointillism” – enough for each student in your class
7. Paint in various colors – individual containers with paints in the box – enough for each student in your class
8. Bag with Q-tips
9. Paper plate to dispose of dirty Q-tips – In the middle of the table for a group of children sitting together; approximately 8

Class materials – each child should have these materials

1. Pencils
2. Brown colored pencil/crayon

Instructions:

1. Place one sheet, one paint container, and 4 Q-tips at each child’s desk. Place one paper plate in the middle of each groups of desks.

The children will paint with one Q-tip per paint color. When they are finished with their color they can exchange with a classmate for a different paint color. They can place used Q-tips on the paper plates.
